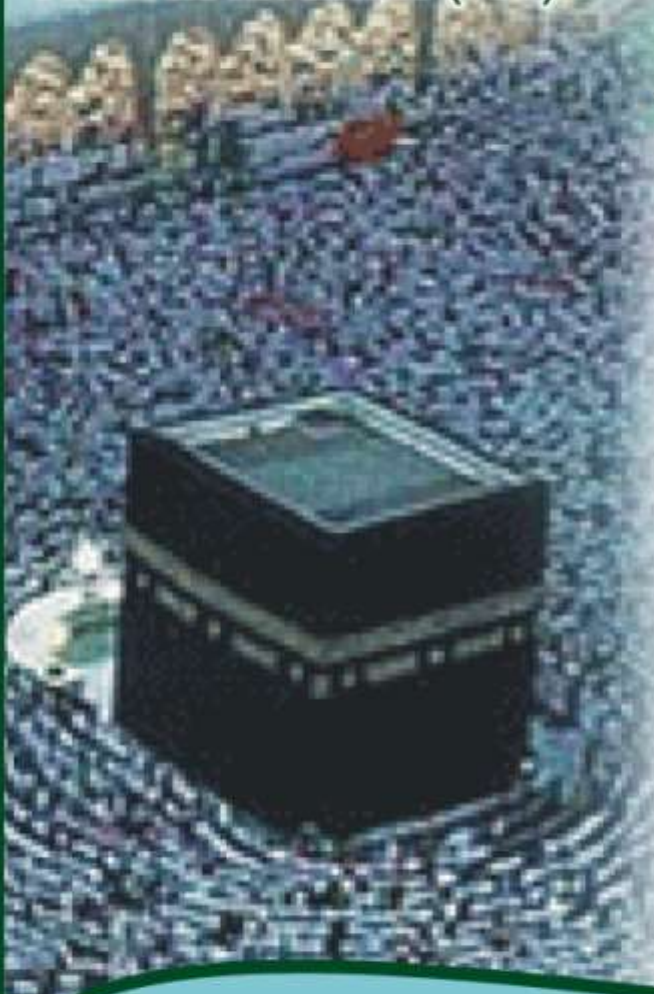

Maj Gen Musarrat Nawaz Malik also visited the Display Room and was briefed on most common drug concealment methods in practice by drug traffickers.

PRESENTATION – REVISED ANF NATIONAL NARCOTICS CONTROL POLICY FORCE COMMANDER (PUNJAB)

On 2nd August 2016, Force Commander (Punjab) Brig Syed Mahmood-Ul-Hassan presented revised ANF National Narcotics Control Policy at HQ ANF. The conference was attended by DG ANF and senior staff officers of HQ ANF.

FC (Punjab) briefed the prevailing drug scenario, latest drug estimates, control at entry / exit points, flow of goods / passengers at airports / border points, quantum of traffic on highways, cooperation amongst LEAs & proposed re-sighting of force. Special emphasis was paid for technical up-gradation to counter modern trends being used in drug smuggling. The input of presentation was greatly appreciated; however certain improvements in light of group-discussion were also suggested to be considered.

He appraised regular use of opium in Chitral, especially in Alkari (Garam Chishma) and Borgan, which is brought from neighboring Afghanistan. He requested exclusive beds for treatment of addicts from Chitral at MATRC Islamabad, which is being considered.

CASE STUDY

PATIENT AT MATRC (KARACHI)

Muhammad Hassan 23, resident of Lyari, Karachi is under treatment at MATRC Karachi. Prior to his shifting at Karachi, Muhammad Hassan used to live at Chiniot along with his family comprising his mother, four brothers and a sister. After completing his primary education, he left schooling & adopted profession of a salesman at a local cloth store, earning Rs. 15000/- per month. To date, he is still a bachelor.

Hassan told that he fell prey to addiction because of weak family bond. Resultantly, peer pressure overcame to trap in addiction, without any check / restriction. He was 18, when he started using heroin and hashish. Sooner he found himself severely addicted to drugs, and also indulged in alcoholic habit. Since last two and half years, his addiction level to four to five times a day, by spending about Rs. 300/- per day. Hassan told that price hike of drugs over last couple of years has compelled him for begging money from his relatives. Due to his addiction, his peers used to avoid giving money to him.

Hassan told that his declining health, supplemented by his irrational behavior triggered alarm among in his family and they came to know about his addiction. Initially he got good beating from his family members, due to which he got repulsive and left home. After spending one month with different friends, he was being rejected by everyone and was left nowhere to go. Hassan himself felt social isolation, for he has been stigmatized as “Drug Addict” and none around him seemed to trust him anymore.

In this distressed condition, motherhood played the pivotal role of sympathy, love and affection. His mother brought him back to home and started living in his room, to safeguard him from repulsion attitude and hate speech of family members. Sooner he realized that his mother was being labeled as “addict’s mother”, which he never expected for his mother. So it was time he started asking help to get rid from drug abuse.

Hassan became obedient to his mother more than ever before. His mother looked for help for his child from a close relative, associated with pharmaceutical business at Karachi. Since Hassan belonged to a lower social class and was unable afford expensive treatment, his relative guided to free drug treatment center at Karachi. Consequently, they immediately approached MATRC Karachi and got admitted. At present Hassan is in fourth week of treatment, whereby family sessions are being conducted by psychologists.

Hassan and his family are completely satisfied with the treatment being provided at MATRC. Hassan is determined to lead a drug free, healthy and respectable life. The big challenge of his determination is still in awaiting, the peers of home-town.

ANF SUPPORT - INTERNATIONAL DRUG OVERDOSE DAY (SAVE TOMORROW)
BY KARIM KHAN AFRIDI WELFARE FOUNDATION (KKAWF)

On 27th Aug 2016, Karim Khan Afridi Welfare Foundation (KKAWF) organized an event titled “Save Tomorrow” to mark International Drug Overdose Day, at Sports Complex Islamabad. Event was attended by Dignitaries, Govt Officials, Foreigners, NGOs, Educational institutions, Sportsman (Cyclists), Singers, General Public and Media Persons. Event was sponsored by ANF, United States Education Foundation (USEF), NCD, Serena Hotel, FM-91 & UNODC.

Aim of the event was to create awareness regarding drug overdose losses, especially amongst youth and reduce the stigma of legal and illegal drug-related death. Event also acknowledged the grief felt by families and friends remembering those who have met with death or permanent injury as a result of drug overdose, hence providing an opportunity to publicly mourn for loved ones, without feeling of guilt or shame.

All the participants were supposed to enlist at registration counters, separate for both genders. The participants were offered with T-Shirts, which turned the venue in Yellowish costume, marking chests with “*Time to Remember, Time to Act*” and backs with “*Save Tomorrow*”. The event was organized to allow everyone’s active participation in 4 categories of Cycle Races i.e. Junior Cyclists, Teen-age Cyclists, Young Cyclists and Professional Cyclists. Cycling events were, encouraged with shouts, claps & whistles on every round of cycling around the stadium. The participants and spectators all cherished the event, greatly because of an amazing occasion, usually missed out in our routine lives.

The later part of event included performance of singers. Prize Distribution Ceremony was preceded by speeches of Ms Christina von Sperling Afridi President Karim Khan Afridi Foundation, Brig Muhammad Basharat ex HQ ANF, Mr. Raja Nadir Ali Secretary Inter-Provincial Coordination, Mr Ijaz Ali Khan Secretary NCD, Cesar Guedes Country Representative of UNODC.

Due to unexpected heavy rain, the elaborate arrangements were shuffled at the last moment, but amicably managed to go with the pace of planned affairs including refreshments.

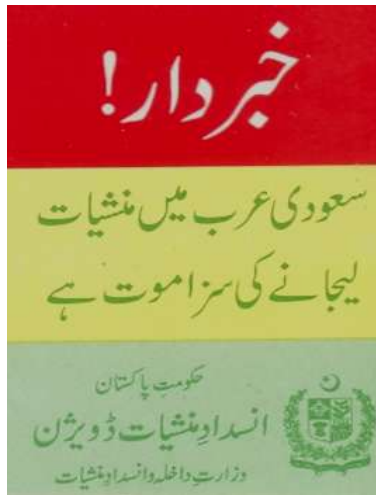
ANF HAJJ OPERATION – “CLEAN JOURNEY”

In addition to normal functioning, ANF undertakes special arrangements for awareness and Drug Free Travelling of Pilgrims for Hajj. It includes earmarking of special ANF staff at Hajji Camps and Airports, who ensure avoidance of any narcotics related drugs to take off from Pakistani soil. Requisite alarm to every pilgrim is ensured about drug charges at Pakistan, KSA and Islamic concept vis-à-vis sinful act for Holy Journey.

ANF staff also undertakes Drug Awareness Campaign for pilgrims, including pasting and distribution of awareness material, anti-drug announcements at airports, display of anti-drug posters and messages on digital screens. Elaborate arrangements made at all airports and Hajji Camps include following:-

- Pasting of drug awareness stickers on every passport.
- Display of Panaflex & Banners to alert the pilgrims about hazards carrying drugs.
- Dissemination of Handouts, Booklets and Brochures amongst all pilgrims regarding prohibition and consequences of carrying drugs to KSA.
- Requisite warning by announcements through Public Address System at Haji Camps / Airports.
- Awareness Campaign (through Electronic & Print Media).
- Display of anti-drug messages on digital screens at airports.
- Appropriate warnings for avoidance of others baggage.

This year 139626 pilgrims have travelled from Pakistan for Hajj. A total of 465 Flights have taken off from different Pakistani Airports. ANF wishes a clean journey to all pilgrims.

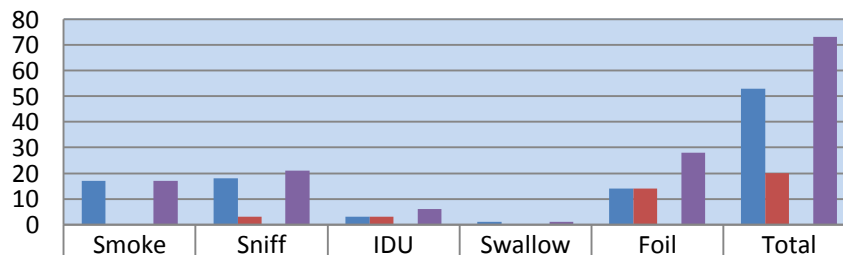


Addiction Period (Yrs)



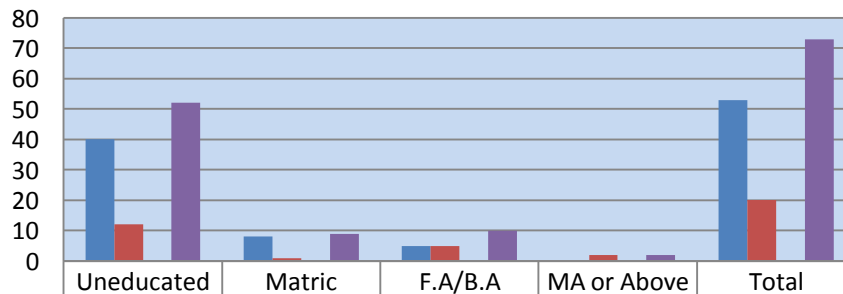

Mode of Addiction

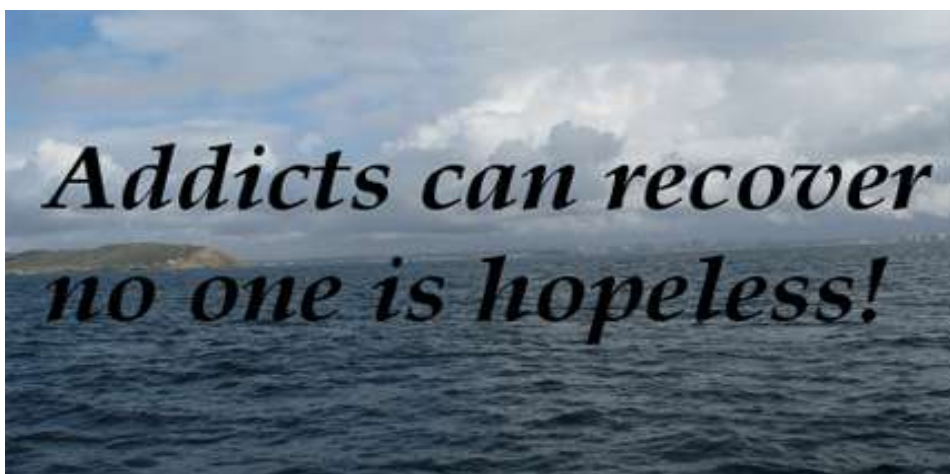
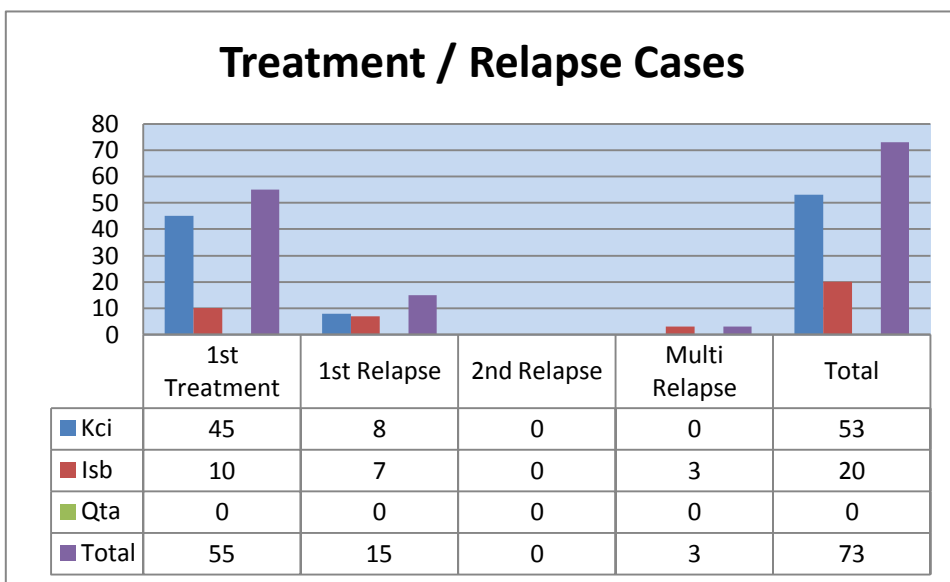
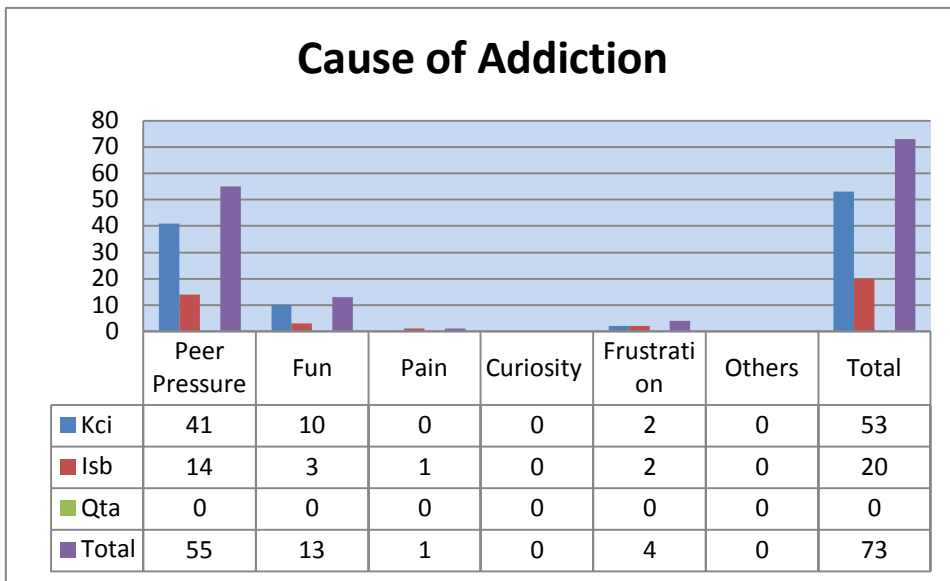
