51ST SESSION OF SUB-COMMISSION ON DRUGS AT SAUDI ARABIA

20 TO 24 NOVEMBER 2016

51st Session of Sub-Commission on Drugs was held at Saudi Arabia from 20 to 24 November 2016. DG ANF Major General Nasir Dilawar Shah HI (M) represented Pakistan in this meeting. The purpose of visit is to attend 51st Session of Sub-Commission on illicit Drug trafficking and related matters in the near and Middle East. This is an advisory forum to formulate draft regional policies, which are presented in upcoming meeting for Commission on Narcotic Drugs (CND). While using this key podium, Pakistan has voiced its national stance, leading to adoption in regional standpoint, which will be presented in forthcoming session at Vienna, most likely to be held in March 2017.



This year main agenda points of the meeting include strengthen cooperation and coordination against trafficking, current trends and modus operandi in trafficking in amphetamine-type stimulants, new psychoactive substances & pharmaceutical preparations, comprehensive & balanced drug-related policies, specific needs of children and youth to prevent drug abuse and need of criminal justice system for under-age drug offenders.

This Sub-commission was established in 1973 and its meetings of Sub-commission are held annually. There are 23 members of the Sub-commission including Pakistan, Afghanistan, India, Iran and states from Middle East & Central Asia. In addition to the main objectives of the sub-commission i.e. to serve as a consultative body which provide the CND with a regional perspective on dealing with illicit drugs, it also facilitates cooperation and coordination in regional activities directed against illicit drug traffic and identifies priority issues and formulate recommendations to the Commission for addressing these issues.

UNODC & PAKISTAN SIGN COUNTRY PROGRAM AT VIENNA

Government of Pakistan and UN office on Drugs & Crime (UNODC) signed a 70 Million US\$, Country Program. The signing took place at Vienna, between the Deputy Executive Director Aldo Lale-Demoz and Pakistan's Narcotics Control Division Federal Secretary Mr Aijaz Ali Khan in the presence of Pakistan's Ambassador to the United Nations Ayesha Riaz, Director General ANF Mr Nasir Dilawar Shah HI (M), and other staff of Pakistan's permanent mission to the UN.

The overall aim of the program is to enhance the skills and knowledge of law enforcement and criminal justice in overcoming the multi-faceted threats posed by transnational organized crime and to foster greater cooperation amongst neighboring countries to effectively address common challenges in illicit trafficking and border management, criminal justice system and legal reforms, drug demand reduction and punishment.

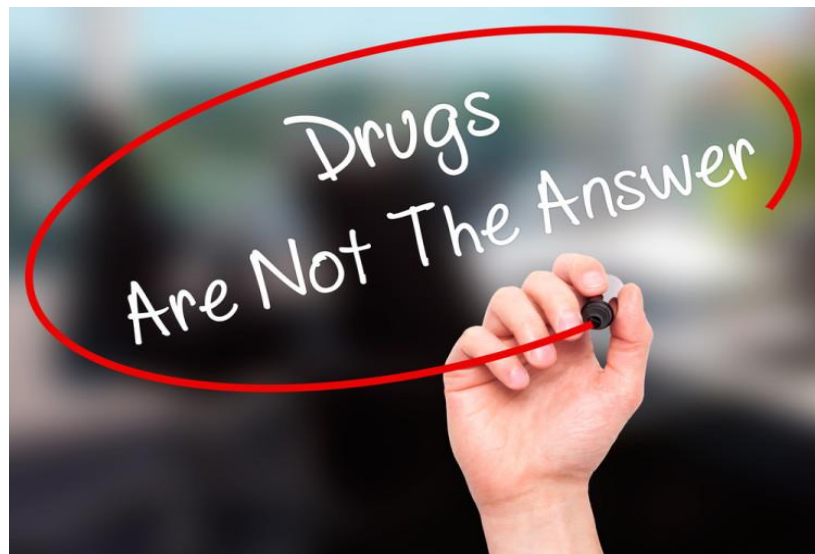
VISIT – INL(P), ERNST & YOUNG (E&Y) PAKISTAN to HQ ANF

ANF LAUNCHED “ANTI-DRUG DRIVE” FOCUSING ON YOUTH

Sequel to directive of DG ANF Major General Nasir Dilawar Shah HI (M), ANF has launched Anti-Drug Campaign, with special focus on youth. This campaign encompasses both Drug Demand Reduction and Drug Supply Reduction aspects.

While undertaking Drug Demand Reduction activities, ANF on 15 November conducted Awareness Walk at Federal Capital and all Provincial Capital cities of the country. It aims at Creating Mass Awareness against the harms of illicit drugs. Venues of the event included walk from GC University to Istanbul Chowk at Lahore, Walk from Agriculture University to University Chowk at Peshawar, walk from Saeedabad Police Training Center Baldia to Graceful Grammar School at Karachi and walk from PTC Chowk Khayaban-e-Iqbal to F-9 Park at Islamabad. People from different walks of life participated in the events, which mostly included Government Officials, Celebrities, NGOs, Media Persons, Students, Teachers, ANF Youth Ambassadors, different LEAs and Civil Society. Efforts were made to attract the maximum participation of students, teachers and parents at one venue, so as to propagate their role in respective capacities. In order to make it a persuasive drive, effective positioning of ANF Youth Ambassadors was ensured, so as to make approving influence in conveying the message to their age-mates.

Respective ANF Force Commanders and selected public representatives made awareness addresses / talks at the terminal-point of walk at respective stations. All the walk sites displayed informational / awareness banners, streamers and pana-flexes. Drug Awareness handouts were also distributed amongst walk-participants and passerby citizens. Special arrangements were also made to distribute awareness brochures at drug infested sites of the cities.

It is pertinent to mention, that ANF has also increased its efforts towards drug treatment. The existing 145 bedded Drug Addiction Treatment facilities held at Islamabad, Quetta and Karachi, is being expanded to 173 more beds at Karachi, Sukkur and Peshawar. The present ANF Drug Demand Reduction Strategy focuses on youth, with the aim that children must be nurtured and protected from drug use and other risky behaviour to ensure that they grow up as healthy, productive members of society.

In addition, ANF has simultaneously undertaken Drug Supply Reduction efforts at educational institutions. Up till now 211 Drug Suppliers to educational institutions have been arrested at Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Jehlum, Lahore, Attock, Haripur, Peshawar, Kohat, Multan, Gilgit, Sukkur, Karachi, Quetta and Qilla Abdullah, resulting in total recovery of 1.404 Tons of Narcotics with an estimated value of Rs 1.28 Billion.

CASE STUDY

PATIENT AT MATRC (ISLAMABAD)

Syed Sami Jamal a 26 year old university student from Chakwal is under treatment at MATRC Islamabad. Patient lives in joint family, which is settled at Islamabad for last couple of years. Both his mother and father are earning hands with a total income of Rs 90,000 per month.

Sami Jamal was a brilliant student, who was about to complete his masters degree. He had wide-spread social circle at university & local community. Back in 2007, during vocations before intermediate result, he used to have late sittings with his neighborhood friends. It was the time when Sami first started taking drugs (heroin) due to peer pressure as recreation. Soon Sami starting enjoying towering amusement; however his addiction remained concealed from family members. Later, he also started experiencing with other drugs i.e. ice, cocaine and alcohol.

As Sami had no specific financial source of his own; he mostly relied on parent's support, but mostly ran short of money. At times in desperate need; he used to borrow money from his friends to fulfill his urge. Though Sami was addicted to multiple drugs with peer-sharing, however he never shared syringes to avoid any blood transmitted deceases.

Addiction badly spoiled his repute and social life; people started staying away from him and calling with hate-labeling, resultantly he was subjected to social isolation. Now the only friendship opening available to him was "addict companionship", so he was dragged into grave addiction. This also led into social lowering i.e. begging / borrowing / stealing, repulsive and desperate. He also started experiencing medical issues. His peers started avoiding him due to violent behavior, who by then also started undermining Law Enforcement Agencies and local elders.

Now his family also became aware about his addiction, however most of them adopted repulsive behavior. Only his mother provided sympathetic support and some financial assistance. Sami's social isolation mostly curtailed him to home, which provided ample time for mother's interaction as well as self-pondering upon his life style. With ample counseling, his mother succeeded to convince for drug treatment. Though Sami tried many times to leave addiction, but due to improper treatment he lost self-control every time and relapsed. On insistence of mother to find a reliable treatment centre, his family succeeded to find MATRC (Islamabad). At present he is under treatment at MATRC for the last 4 weeks and is recovering rapidly.

Sami's recovery from drugs wouldn't have been possible, without intimate concern of his mother, who eventually involved support of whole family. She not only convinced Sami for treatment, but also persuaded whole family to help her to know reliable treatment centre. There is a dire need to create awareness not only against drugs, but also social obligations of near-ones towards addict-patients. We have a vital duty towards drug-patients of our families and society.

Being a healthy member of society, let's not curtail the right of a drug-patient towards us.

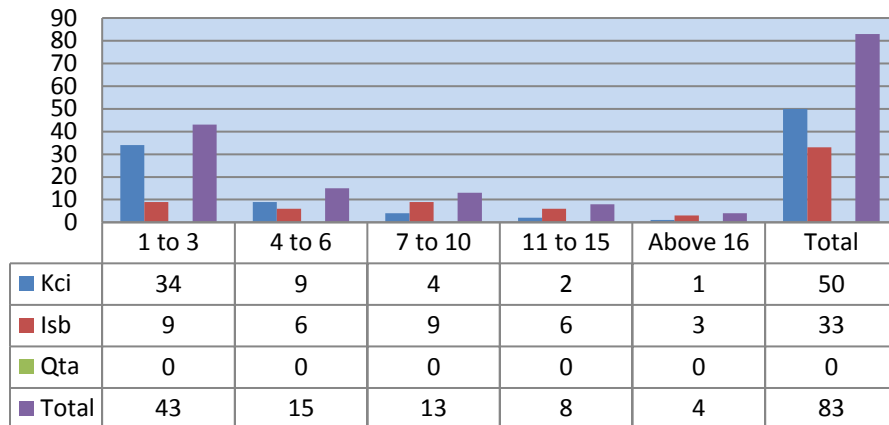

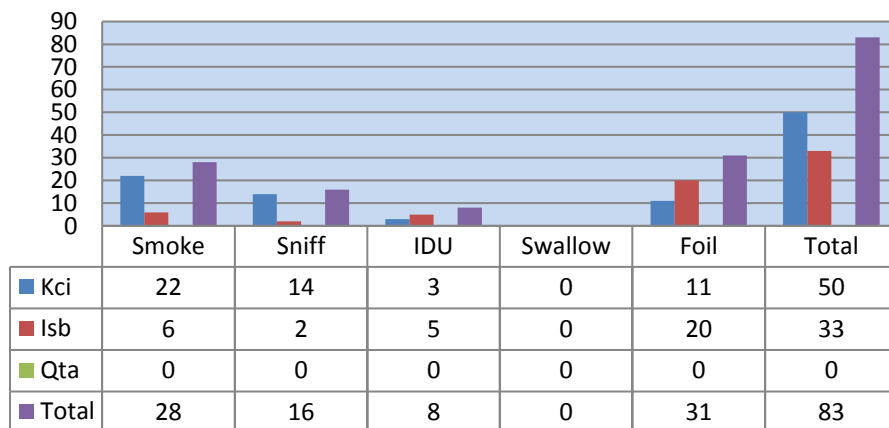
PATIENTS TREATED AT MATRCs - NOV 2016



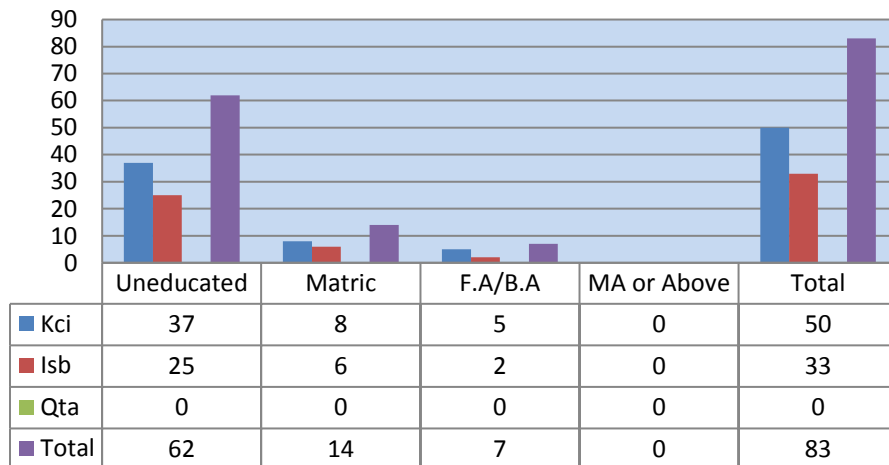
Addiction Period (Yrs)



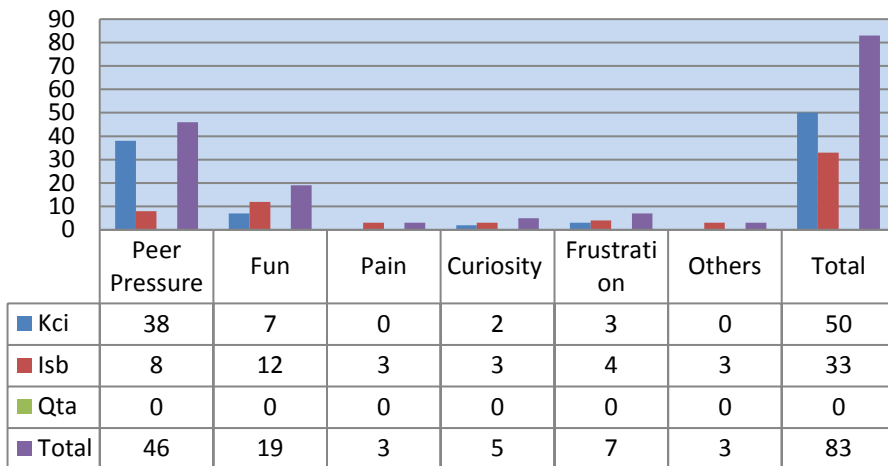
Mode of Addiction



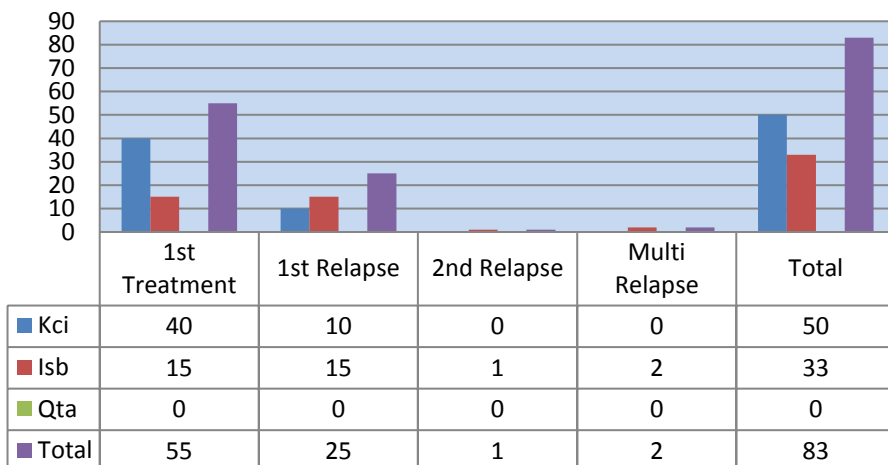
Addicts - Education Level
